(2) Performance ratio is the percentage of ODA in Canada's Gross National Income. GNI is based on latest figures provided in the annual Federal Budgets and/or Budget Updates after 2005-2006.

(3) "Real ODA" is Canadian ODA less amounts included for refugees for their first year in Canada, imputed costs for developing country students studying in Canada, and the value of debt relief included in ODA.
