A. Introduction

The projects listed are derived from Global Affairs Canada's Historical Projects Dataset, 2010/11 to 2015/16.

These projects have been sorted by fiscal year in relation to the first year in which a disbursement was made. The table provides the last year when a disbursement was recorded. It may be that additional disbursements will be made in active projects in 2016/17 and beyond. A hyperlink on the project title brings the reader to GAC project browser information for this project. This browser is updated regularly and some older projects may be removed from time to time.

The projects have been sorted to avoid duplication and according to the approach taken in the paper. The projects' budgets have been adjusted as accordingly:

- 1) Where a project has been marked principal purpose and significant purpose, the full budget is included under principal purpose and is eliminated under significant purpose.
- 2) Where a project has been marked principal purpose adaptation and principal purpose mitigation, the budget for this project is divided 50/50 between these two principal purposes.
- 3) Where a project has been marked significant purpose adaptation and significant purpose mitigation, the budget for this project is divided 50/50 between these two significant purposes.
- 4) For all significant purpose projects the total budget is provided in the table. The total for each fiscal year is adjusted to accommodate the counting of only 30% of the budget for these projects for these purposes.

The projects in these tables do not include any project financed by Environment and Climate Change Canada or the Department of Finance. It is therefore not fully complete and the totals for fiscal year and for the six-year period may be different than the total figures in the paper.

The list of initiatives and projects for the allocation of the \$2.65 billion in climate finance, established in late 2015, was derived from the work of C4D in collating all of the current announcements related to this commitment. It is current as of March 2017.

Every effort has been made to ensure accuracy, and any errors are the responsibility of the author.
